Purpose: Agricultural Issues Advisory Committee is a Committee established by County Council under the Agricultural Service Board.

Appointments made when required.

Policy Statement and Guidelines:

The Agricultural Service Board Committee will undertake a **Coyote Control** Program within it's boundaries under provisions of the *Agricultural Pest Act*.

Upon receipt of a request for Coyote Control materials, the Agricultural Fieldman will thoroughly investigate reasons for the request. If, in the opinion of the Agricultural Fieldman, the request is justified, he may issue a limited number of control materials in accordance with guidelines as outlined by the Pest Control Branch, Alberta Agriculture.

Smoky Lake County Agricultural Service Board will not issue Form 9's – Permit to Destroy Coyotes Using Dogs.

At the discretion of the Agricultural Fieldman, landowners will be informed of alternative measures i.e. hunters and trappers. The County will provide a list of hunters and trappers available to assist landowners in dealing with problem coyotes.
