

PROCLAMATION

HERITAGE MANITOBA MAPLE TREES

WHEREAS: the Victoria District National Historic Site of Canada, located within the Smoky Lake

County, constitutes an important segment of the history of the Western Canadian

settlement experience,

WHEREAS: this includes First Nations and Indigenous peoples, trading, missions, development of

the fur trade, establishment of Métis river lot system, agricultural development, and

Prairie immigration at the beginning of the 20th Century, and

WHEREAS: these immigrants brought with them their cultures and customs, as well as seeds and

seedlings, including 'Manitoba Maple Trees' and

WHEREAS: the Manitoba Maple Trees located at 17339 Victoria Trail along the banks of this

historic North Saskatchewan River (kisiskâciwanisîpiy), on River Lot 12, are likely

more than 160-years-old,

NOW THEREFORE: Smoky Lake County does hereby proclaim the Manitoba Maple Trees located at

Metis Crossing on River Lot 12 as being trees of historic significance.
