Tamarack Acquisition Corp. is done drilling oil well at SE-3-60-17-W4.

Croswell is the only one actively hauling gravel in the County. Have done haul road agreements the pits they may be hauling from this year. (6 agreements)

Jay's Salvage is logging at SW-30-60-W4 and using 165A, 605, 170, and 610 to & from Hwy. 855.

Slash Ventures is logging at W-29-59-16-W4 and using 164 and 165 to & from Hwy. 28.

Tree Tech is at S - 2 - 58 - 13 - W4 and will be going on 131 and 132 to get onto Hwy. 652.

Will be working on Haul Road Agreement for Mantle Materials Group, Ltd. Who has taken over JMB's Pit.

Working on agreement with Donald Tannas to allow him to get his produce out on 152 (75% ban) to Hwy. 28 at 100%. Will be going with time restrictions to allow hauls. This is the only way for him to go.

Have issued 5 Fire Permits.

Still working with Ag Department (Trevor) to try take care of as many problems as possible so there aren't as many problems in spring during run off.

Following up on wash board areas as much as possible. Because of hardly any moisture this fall it was almost impossible to prep the roads for winter. The gravel did not bind and continues to be lose in open areas. Where there is some moisture in treed areas the gravel has bonded with the road. These areas have formed some icy areas that the operators are trying to address them. Because of the dry fall we may end up losing some gravel as it will end up mixing with the snow until we are able to get a base to the road top. This has been one of the worst falls that I can recall for preparing the roads for winter because of it been so dry. The operators have been trying to bench back the snow to keep it off the road tops so the spring run-off will stay in the ditches. We will start cleaning snow in areas that we know there may be flooding.
