
DECLARATION OF A MUNICIPAL AGRICULTURAL DISASTER

At a Special Council Meeting on July 24, 2025, Smoky Lake County Council unanimously voted to declare a Municipal Agricultural Disaster in response to the extremely dry conditions affecting the region. This declaration aims to raise awareness of the challenges our producers are currently facing—and will continue to face in the coming weeks and months—due to widespread drought.

The declaration also emphasizes the significant role agriculture plays—not just in our municipality and province, but across the country and around the world.
