SNOW REMOVAL REMINDERS



When clearing snow from your driveway or approach, please keep all snow on your own property. Do not push snow onto municipal roads, shoulders, or side slopes within the road right-of-way.

When clearing toward the roadway, place snow on the right-hand side of your approach so graders can safely push it away.

Please also ensure your rural address sign remains clear and visible.

Depositing snow on public roads is unsafe and may result in a warning and/or fine under Bylaw 1241-12.
